Dear Parents and carers,

Thank you all for your support in your child's education throughout the pandemic.

We are currently busy planning our full reopening of all our academies in September and welcoming all our young people back to school. As you know we have been open for key worker children and those most vulnerable children during the pandemic and have safely operated our sites for around 200 young people. In September we plan to open our doors for all our young people, including our new students, and want to reassure you that we are developing comprehensive risk assessments and taking steps to keep our young people as safe as possible. We will be publishing our risk assessments on our academy websites so you can see what is being planned to keep your child safe.

We are aiming to restrict the contacts that groups of students have during the school week. This means that if we do have a case of Covid19 we can quickly identify those students and staff who need to isolate. You will receive more information from your child's school that will support their return to school in September.

The expectation is that all students will return to school. If you have any concerns about this please contact your Head teacher. We will do our best to support you and your child in terms of their education and well-being.
